University of Colorado School of Medicine Department of Radiology is seeking an experienced Pediatric Interventional Radiologist. The Department of Radiology includes 30 board certified pediatric radiologists with a subset of 4 pediatric interventionalists in a well-established interventional practice on track to perform over 4000 procedures this year. The pediatric radiology group is based at Children's Hospital Colorado (CHCO), a top regional center consistently rated in the top 10 Children's Hospitals by *U.S. News & World Report*. The CHCO network of care encompasses 585 beds and is academically affiliated with the University of Colorado. Over the past two years CHCO has supported an extensive expansion of the physical space that includes two new interventional

radiology suites containing state of the art equipment and expansion of services to include neuro-interventional therapeutic procedures.

Duties

This physician will serve in the pediatric interventional services, which currently include four pediatric interventional radiologists, two dedicated IR nurse practitioners and will report to the Chief of Pediatric Radiology at CHCO. We are looking for a physician who is a great communicator, advocate of all members on their team, and can bring teams together in a collaborative and inspirational manner. Call responsibilities for Pediatric Interventional Radiologists are typically every fourth night and weekend. Fellow, resident, and medical student education in both an outpatient and inpatient setting are components of the position.
