Diagnostic Cerebral AngiogramsCincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center (CCHMC) is a large tertiary hospital with a locoregional and international referral base. The hospital is among the five largest by number of registered beds and is consistently ranked as one of the top pediatric hospitals in the United States. The fellowship at CCHMC is a one-year fellowship following either a diagnostic pediatric radiology fellowship or integrated IR/DR residency or independent adult IR fellowship. Fellows can be admitted for only the IR fellowship or for a 2-year combined diagnostic pediatric radiology and pediatric interventional radiology fellowship. Three months of elective time are provided, allowing fellows additional training in neuro IR, adult IR or diagnostic pediatric radiology. The IR department has three state-of-the-art dedicated IR suites and hybrid IR/OR suite. There is also an Interventional Radiology Translational Research and Simulation Lab (IR-TRSL) that allows skills training and research opportunities. <https://www.cincinnatichildrens.org/research/cores/ir-trsl>
