

Pediatric Interventional Radiologist

The Department of Medical Imaging at Ann & Robert H. Lurie Children's Hospital of Chicago (Lurie Children's) and Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine seek a full-time non-tenure-eligible Clinician-Educator with sub-specialty expertise in Pediatric Interventional Radiology. Working with the Chair of Medical Imaging and Pediatric Interventional Radiology faculty, the candidate will participate in clinical and education activities related to Lurie Children's Department of Medical Imaging. Duties include performing interventional procedures, participating in outpatient clinics, consulting with referring clinicians, educating and mentoring trainees, and contributing to divisional and institutional research efforts.

Qualified candidates must have completed an ACGME-accredited fellowship or residency in Vascular and Interventional Radiology, and be IR/DR board certified or eligible. Preference will be given to applicants with experience in Pediatric Interventional Radiology and academic interest. Applicants must be eligible for an academic appointment at Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine.

The Department of Medical Imaging is home to 31 radiologists who provide the complete spectrum of diagnostic and interventional pediatric imaging care. The Division of Pediatric Interventional Radiology performs nearly 4,000 procedures annually. Procedures are performed in two dedicated single-plane IR suites and one dedicated biplane suite, as well as dedicated pre/post procedure areas. The Division includes dedicated body and neuro interventional radiologists, as well as three nurse practitioners.
