Nemours Children's Hospital, Delaware is searching for a fellowship-trained pediatric interventional radiologist to join our growing and dynamic team in Wilmington, Delaware. Qualified candidates must be board-certified or eligible, and current fellows are encouraged to apply. The candidate will participate full-time in the Division of Interventional Radiology and will receive an academic appointment at the Sidney Kimmel Medical College of Thomas Jefferson University (Philadelphia, PA) commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Nemours Radiology is one of the largest pediatric radiology groups in the United States, comprised of 40 pediatric radiologists working together to provide state-of-the-art diagnostic and interventional radiology services at our locations in Delaware, Florida, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania. In 2021, approximately 380,000 imaging examinations were performed across the system. Faculty are licensed in all four states and credentialed throughout the system as well as partner institutions.

The Division of Interventional Radiology consists of 3 full-time fellowship-trained Interventional Radiologists, two adjunct adult Interventional Radiologists, and two physician assistants on-site with state-of-the-art IR suites. There are 9 interventional radiologists within the Nemours Enterprise Division of Interventional Radiology. Together, we are a collaborative team with cross-campus credentialing at our 3 hospitals - Nemours Children's Hospital, Delaware (Wilmington), Nemours Children's Hospital, Florida (Orlando), and Wolfson Children's Hospital (Jacksonville Florida). IR is a full-service division offering the entire range of interventional procedures, on the forefront of the cutting edge including complex lymphatic flow disorders, Y90-therapy of liver tumors, vascular anomalies, and solid organ transplant interventions. The division prioritizes support for the exploration of new techniques and the growth of subspecialty programs
