In early 2025, the division implemented Visage7, which brings cutting-edge advanced technology to the radiology and imaging space. A brand new, state-of-the-art interventional suite opened in 2025.

The group is the largest in South Florida devoted exclusively to the practice of pediatric radiology with the only ACGME-accredited pediatric radiology fellowship program in South Florida.
