We also have a dedicated vascular IR program.

We perform procedures such as:

Image-guided biopsies - USG , CT

Drainage of fluid collections

Central venous access placement

Angiography and angioplasty

Embolisation procedures for Oncology , Transplant and Pediatric

Cholangiography and biliary drainage - HPB interventions and Liver transplantations

Urological drainage procedures incl nephrostomy and ureteric stent insertion

Gastrointestinal access – placement and maintenance of gastrojejunal feeding tubes

Management of post-surgical and post-transplant complications

Diagnosis and management of vascular anomalies - Adult and Pediatrics
